News

Automation and innovation are becoming the new normal across different industries and organisations around the world. The project TransIT aims to develop work-based competencies that can support European SMEs manage the transition to Industry 4.0 and adopt all the related innovations brought by disrupting technologies. The managers of small companies will then be able and more technically competent to face the challenges of digitalization.

As the world approaches what seems to be the end of the CoVid-19 pandemic, the new cooperation arrangements brought by the possibility to work remotely and in a digitally based way, the consortium has worked in the past few months to prepare more meaningful activities for the management of these new opportunities. TransIT is ready to move forward with the pilot testing of such activities.

During December 2021, the partnership has met in Cascais, Portugal for the second Short-term Joint Staff Training (C2). This was hosted by Weople from the 7th to the 9th of December. The theme of the Learning Activity was to explore the Training exercises & best practices for the pilot training. The partners thus worked on a different set of activities exploring the main areas covered by the Triple Training Kit (foreseen in Intellectual Output 2 of the project): Innovation Thinking, Motivation Management & Technical Collaboration. The Learning Activity explored also other current topics in the area of digital cooperation, such as the organization of Zoom meetings (thanks to the trainer Katalin Fulop) and the Spirit Carfts Outdoor training program, led by Anna Losonczy and Darinka Pozsik.


Our next Transnational Partners meeting will be held in Bulgaria, in 2022!

Notable accomplishments/Outputs
